## Information Booklet

### Rules for admission to Post Doctoral Certificate course (Neuro-anaesthesia)

2009

#### 1. Jurisdiction of the University

1.1. Admission to 2 (two) seats in the One year Post Doctoral Certificate Course (Neuro-anaesthesia) at Bangur Institute of Neurology, I.P.G.M.E. & R., Kolkata shall be made on the basis of merit list of candidates appearing in the West Bengal Neuro-anaesthesia Admission Test Examinations (WBNAAT) to be conducted by the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS) as detailed in Section 4 below.

#### 2. Eligibility criteria :

- 2.1 Citizens of India who have obtained the requisite Post Graduate Medical degree (MD) in Anaesthesia (or equivalent qualifications as determined by Medical Council of India from time to time) from any MCI-recognized Institution of India shall be eligible to apply for admission.
- 2.2 Application for admission will not be accepted unless the candidates have got themselves registered either with WB Medical Council or with the Medical Council of India.
- 2.3 However, a candidate who is likely to pass the requisite Post Graduate Medical degree examination by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2009 can take up WBNAAT, but he/she shall not be eligible for admission unless he/she produces the proof of passing the said examination from a MCI-recognized institution during counseling.
- 2.4 Candidates who are pursuing any course, other than Post Graduate Medical degree course as mentioned in 2.3 above, are not eligible for admission till they complete the course or they are likely to complete the course within 31.07.2009. Candidates are permitted to apply provided that they either complete the course being pursued on or before 31.07.2009 or resign from the undergoing course before admission.

#### 3. Method of Submission of application

- 3.1. Information Booklet and Application Form can be downloaded from [www.thewbuhs.org](http://www.thewbuhs.org).

- 3.2. The candidate will, first of all, visit the university website [www.thewbuhs.org](http://www.thewbuhs.org) through internet. He/ She is required to go through the '**Information Booklet**' carefully and acquaint himself/herself with all requirements regarding filling in the application form.
- 3.3. In the homepage he/ she will click '**PDCC Neuro-anaesthesia FORM**' to download the form.
- 3.4. Please submit the filled application form to the office of the 'Controller of Examinations, West Bengal University of Health Sciences, DD-36, Sector-I, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064' after:
  - i) pasting two photographs of the candidate (one of which must be attested by a gazetted officer or Principal of the candidate's college) at appropriate places,
  - ii) putting the candidate's signature & thumb impression at appropriate places,
  - iii) attaching the bank-draft of Rs. 2000/- in favour of 'The West Bengal University of Health Sciences' payable at Kolkata and
  - iv) attaching an unstamped self-addressed envelope.Please follow the instructions scrupulously before submitting the form either personally or by registered post/ speed post so as to reach WBUHS on or before 14.08.2009.  
Please keep photocopy of the form for your records.  
Please mention the name of the 'course applied for' on the envelope.  
All forms submitted after the stipulated last date will be rejected without any further reference to the candidate and the fees submitted, if any, will be forfeited as processing charges.

#### **4. Selection process**

- 4.1 The selection of candidates will be done on the basis the marks obtained in the Admission test (WBNAAT) / or by Interview whichever is necessary.
- 4.2. Applicants will be provisionally allowed to appear in the Admission tests provided they have submitted application in the prescribed forms within the last date and have fulfilled the eligibility criteria outlined above.
- 4.3. The question papers for the Admission tests shall be set in English
- 4.4. The question paper for the Admission test shall contain 100 single best response type Multiple Choice Questions on Anaesthesia and allied subjects.
- 4.5. The duration of the admission test will be 80 minutes.
- 4.6. For each correct response, three (3) marks will be awarded. One (1) mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer. More than a single response to any question will be treated as incorrect response. No marks will be deducted for questions not attempted.
- 4.7. The provisional merit list will be published on the basis of marks obtained in the Admission examination/Interview.
- 4.8. Qualifying marks for empanelment for selection will be a minimum of 150 marks

#### **5. Merit List of Candidates Qualifying in the Admission Test**

- 5.1. The rank of a candidate qualifying in the Admission test will be determined on the basis of the marks obtained by him/her as in clause 4.6. above. The roll numbers of the candidates qualifying in the Admission test will be arranged in the merit list according to rank and in order of decreasing marks. Seats may be kept reserved for West Bengal Govt. sponsored candidates, if available.
- 5.2. In the event of more than one candidate securing the same marks in the Admission test, the rank shall be determined according to the following principles:

- 5.2.1. The relative position of such candidates in the merit list will be determined on the basis of the number of correct answers, i.e., the candidate scoring more positive marks out of the 100 questions under consideration; will be placed in higher position in the merit list.
  - 5.2.2. If the ranks cannot be determined by the above principle, the ranks will be determined by the total number of failures/ missed chances in the relevant qualifying MD Examination, wherever applicable. Candidates having lesser failures/ missed chances will be placed at a higher rank. For example, the candidate who has passed in single chance will be placed in a higher position in the merit list than a candidate who passed by availing more than one chance.
  - 5.2.3. If the ranks cannot be determined by the above principle, the ranks will be determined by the total number of failures/ missed chances in the MBBS Examinations. Candidates having lesser failures/ missed chances will be placed at a higher rank. For example, the candidate who has passed in single chance will be placed in a higher position in the merit list than a candidate who passed by availing more than one chance.
  - 5.2.4. If the ranks of the candidates cannot be determined by application of the above principles, the candidate older by age will be in the higher rank than the candidate younger by age.
- 5.3. The Competent Authority will prepare a Final Merit List after necessary corrections, if any, in the provisional Merit List. Only corrections may be displayed on the University Website.

## **6. Other information**

- 6.1. Candidates need not submit any supporting document along with their application form.
- 6.2. The allotment of centre will be done by WBUHS and will be final and binding. The centre once allotted shall not be changed.
- 6.3. There is no provision for rechecking/ re-evaluation of the answer sheets and no query in this regard will be entertained.

### **GENERAL RULES AND PROCEDURAL DIRECTIVES**

1. Applicants should go through and strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Booklet as published in [www.thewbuhs.org](http://www.thewbuhs.org) in August 2009. Application must be complete in all respect.
2. Applicants are required to enclose a self addressed unstamped envelop (approx. size: 25 cm. x12 cm.) along with the application for sending the Admit Card. The application along with a crossed Demand Draft of Rs. 2000/- in favour of 'The West Bengal University of Health Sciences' payable at Kolkata is to be submitted by Speed/ Registered post to the 'Controller of Examinations, West Bengal University of Health Sciences, DD-36, Sector-I, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064', so that it reaches the office of the WBUHS within 14.08.2009. Candidates are requested to write name and his telephone number the back of the bank draft.
3. No other document is to be submitted with application form.
4. Submission of incorrect or false statements / documents or suppression of material information in the application form will be considered as sufficient ground for cancellation of the candidature or the admission of the candidates to a Post Doctoral medical course whenever detected, i.e. during the process of admission or even at any stage thereafter.
5. The selection / admission of a candidate shall stand cancelled if he / she is found guilty of copying from any material whatsoever or of taking the help of any electronic media / devices during the examination, or of assisting others or of being assisted by others in any manner whatsoever in writing

out the answers during the examination. In this context, decision of the Centre-in-charge will be final and binding.

6. Admit Card will be sent by speed post.
7. In case Admit Card does not reach the applicant, he/she should appear **in person** to the office of the Controller of Examinations, WBUHS, according to the time schedule mentioned in this booklet, for issuance of the duplicate Admit Card.
8. The qualified candidates whose names will be published in the Provisional Merit List will have to submit all the attested copies of supporting documents along with originals for verification of their eligibility to the course before admission.
9. The Merit list and further direction to the candidates will be notified in the notice-board of the WBUHS and will also be available in the website <www.thewbuhs.org>. No communication in this regard will be made to the candidates personally.
10. The successful candidates should report to the head of the institution within 14.09.2009. Failure to report will render the seat vacant.
11. If a candidate does not report to the allotted institution his / her admission to the course will be cancelled.
12. No travel allowance is admissible for appearing in the Admission examination or for attending counseling.
13. No personal communication will be made to the candidates, unless it is considered absolutely necessary by the University authority.
